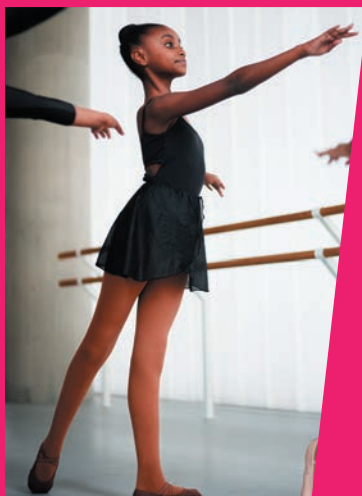

The programme is spearheaded by English National Ballet, one of the world's greatest dance companies, in association with Dupont Dance Stage School in Leicester.

Following an audition, the Ballet Futures participants will receive

- free weekly training at the Dupont Dance Stage School
- financial support towards ballet shoes and school uniform
- the chance to work with English National Ballet dancers, artists and teachers throughout the year
- backstage access to English National Ballet's home in East London, the Mulryan Centre for Dance, with additional support towards travel to and from East London.
